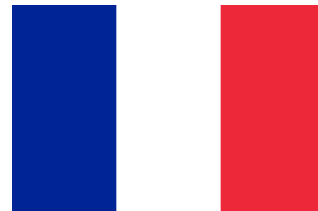

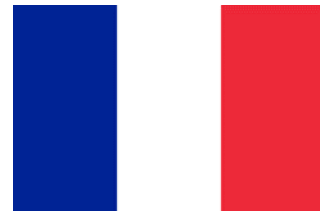

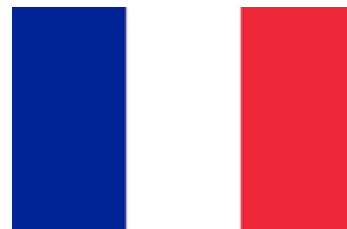

No particular problem to report as far as port activities are concerned. However, on 16/04/21, the crew on board M/V "KIARA" – A CMA-CGM vessel - underwent a routine COVID check. 4 crew members were found affected. The vessel was hence isolated at anchor for 7 days, after which she was allowed to berth and proceed with the cargo ops.

The population on the whole island is creating havoc by blocking the roads and creating very long traffic jams. Travelling to and from the Port of Longoni is getting rather painful.

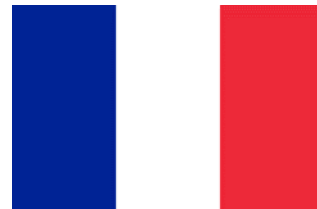

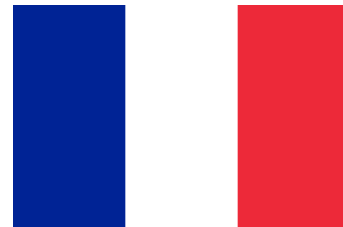

- CONFINEMENT** : The massive gathering of people (more than 10 persons) is prohibited. It is obligatory for all citizens in the Albanian territory to wear a mask even in open spaces. The children younger than 11 years and other persons that cannot wear a mask on health reasons are excluded from this obligation. Currently there is a curfew during period 22 :00 – 06 :00.
- NON ESSENTIAL BUSINESS' CLOSURE** : Businesses are open, including bars and restaurants, which are required to respect safety protocols.
- BORDERS' CLOSURE** : Land borders of Albania with neighboring countries for the free movement of people are opened. Actually all nationalities are allowed to enter in Albania. Trucks and other cargo movement are allowed and continue normally.

2. Port's situation (max. 10 lines)

All seaports are open. There are no restrictions in handling of cargo vessels, ro-ro vessels, tankers and gas-carriers. Ferry boats vessels (including passengers) to/from Italian ports are allowed. Both shipping lines and passengers should respect the safety protocols. Actually all nationalities are allowed to enter in Albania. The yachts and other touristic boats are allowed in ports. From 3rd May, travellers from Greece and North Macedonia may enter Albania freely without obligatory quarantine.

CONFINEMENT : Wearing respirators compulsory in public transport, at bus/tram/metro stations, shops and inside all buildings. Services (hairdresser, cosmetic and massage salons, etc.) opened for customers with negative covid test. Retail sale opened again and operating under strict hygiene rules, botanical gardens and ZOOs opened allowing 50% capacity only. Outside areas of restaurants opened again. Distance learning still partially in place, but students/pupils are expected to fully return to schools next week. Home office style of work is still recommended to companies. Weekly testing of employees is compulsory for all companies. The health care system's capacities are stable and elective care is operational again. Daily numbers of newly infected people have been continuously decreasing in the recent weeks. Vaccination of high risk citizens and citizens of age 40+ (this week) in a process.

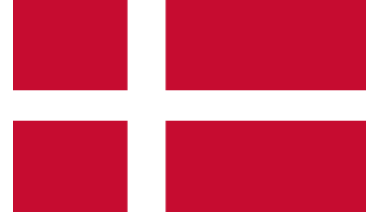

The crew of foreign-flagged vessels calling at the Latvian ports shall be prohibited from coming ashore, except the specific cases to be agreed upon when necessary for the normal operation of the ship. Crew change in Latvia is not prohibited if the transportation of the seafarer from Latvia can be arranged. It should be noted that in practice disembarkation of Covid-19 infected crewmembers from a ship to a special hotel is very complicated due to absence of special rules for transportation of such patients and reluctance of private carriers to accept Covid-19 positive passengers. Surveyors' attendance can be arranged without complications.

Since 26 of February 2021 a person is allowed to travel to Latvia only in case of urgent necessity due to work, for receiving of medical services, for transit, and in other cases specified by Cabinet Rules No.655 (clause 5.49.1.1). It is compulsory for all persons, who are planning to cross Latvian border, to complete an electronic form at the web portal <https://www.covidpass.lv/en/> before crossing the border. Entering Latvia all persons aged 12 and older are required to have a document confirming a negative COVID-19 test made at least 72 hours prior to boarding the carrier's transport. This requirement shall not apply to seafarers who must reach their work place aboard a ship or must return from it, and in other situations specified in point 35.4 of Cabinet Regulation No 360. After arriving from a country with a high incidence of COVID-19 (more than 50 cases per 100,000 inhabitants) a ten-day self-isolation is compulsory, except if the person has recovered from Covid-19, has antibodies, and this fact is confirmed by a medical statement.

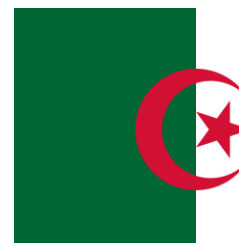

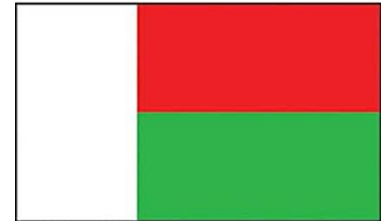

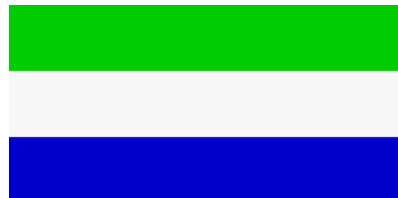

The rest of the variants identified in the country are the UK (B.1.1.7), South Africa (B.1.351), Nigeria (B.1.525) and Brazilian (P1) variants of the coronavirus. ■ The government and public health experts are concerned about a possible third wave of Covid-19 in early June due to the detection of the Indian variant of the virus in Bangladesh. ■ **The country also logged a total of 783,737 coronavirus cases and total deaths 12,248 and total recovered from Covid-19 726,132 as of 20th May-21 at 8:36GMT.** ■ **Banks** will continue to operate on weekdays until 2:00pm until May 23, after the government decided to again extend the ongoing restrictions on public movement and gathering in a bid to stop further spread of Covid-19. However, branches will remain open until 2:30pm to complete their regular procedures ■ **Non-bank Financial institutions** to reopen for emergency services on a limited scale amid a lockdown over the coronavirus outbreak. Bangladesh has 34 non-bank Financial institutions. ■ **Police** to get magistracy power to ensure that everyone wears a mask; by amending the Infectious Diseases (Prevention, Control and Eradication) Act-2018 to make people wear masks due to lack of manpower to conduct mobile courts. ■ In the wake of the spread of Covid-19 virus in March last year, the government shut down the **country's educational** institutions; would remain closed until May 29. The government has decided to ensure vaccination of all students before opening colleges and universities for in-person academic activities.

Covid: Anvisa updates guidelines for ports and vessels

[Texto em português abaixo]

On April 30th, the National Health Surveillance Agency (ANVISA) published Technical Note 5/2021, which updates and effectively compiles the guidelines for ports and vessels in this period of the Covid pandemic.

The Technical Note brings a detailed definition for “close contact” in a vessel and the port area, with subtle but important differences. Thus, if there are thirty crew members or fewer on the vessel, they are all considered closed contacts and subject to quarantine.

Either way, the Technical Note states that if there is a possible or confirmed case of COVID-19 on a vessel coming from a foreign port, all the crewmembers shall be tested.

If there is a possible COVID-19 case, the vessel will be in quarantine for 14 days. However, the quarantine can be lifted from the tenth day onwards if all crewmembers are tested negative (PCR test)

The Technical Note leaves it open for the Authority to consider if the 14 days period will begin on the day that the sample for the test is collected on the day of the onset of the symptoms. Still, it states clearly that the 14 days period will restart if there is another case registered on board.

The prohibition of maritime cruises and the restriction of disembarking of crewmembers remain in place, except for those related to repatriation and medical or dental assistance, according to Ordinance No. 652 of January 25, 2021 and its updates.

Another relevant update occurred on May 14th, when ANVISA published Ordinance 653/2021, which bans passenger flights from and with a passage in India, maintaining similar bans for South Africa and the United Kingdom only cargo flights.

The negative news of the day is that the number of patients with the disease grew to 25,554 from the 24,735 that there was yesterday Monday 10th May. Of these, 525 are admitted to Intensive Care Unit which at the moment have a "stable capacity".

The government will decide this week whether to maintain or abolish the measures adopted to reduce mobility among which are the closure of clubs and gyms and the suspension of public performances.

It is estimated that by the 8th June, the entire population that is scheduled will receive at least their first dose of the vaccine. Tomorrow Thursday 13th June, a shipment of Pfizer vaccines (80,000 doses) and AstraZeneca vaccines (50,400 doses) will be arriving in Uruguay.

The tentative calendar indicates that as from May 31, the fourth, fifth and sixth year schoolchildren from the interior of the country, would return to face-to-face classes.

The Australian government has banned the export of some equipment that could help efforts to stop the spread of COVID-19, including: disposable face masks, disposable gloves, disposable gowns, goggles, glasses or eye visors, alcohol wipes, hand sanitizer.

All commercial vessels must now use the Maritime Arrivals Reporting System (MARS) for all vessel pre-arrival reporting.

All vessels entering Australia that have a suspected case of COVID-19 on board will not be allowed to unload goods or disembark travellers until cleared to do so by the human biosecurity officer.

Where vessels have a suspected case of COVID-19 on board, a human biosecurity officer will screen for COVID-19, determine the appropriate course of action and issue directions.

State Borders reopened across Australia.

Transport or freight of goods is exempt from border controls on the condition that the person performing the services must meet State exemption requirements; hold and display a border permit, wear a mask, practise social distancing, remain self-quarantined and submit a COVID-19 management plan.
