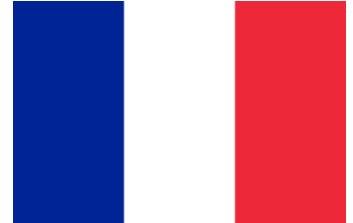

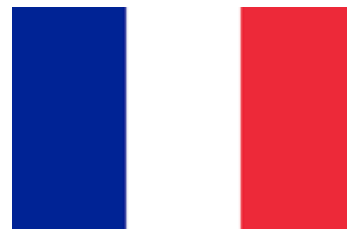

No particular problem to report as far as port activities are concerned. However, on 16/04/21, the crew on board M/V "KIARA" – A CMA-CGM vessel - underwent a routine COVID check. 4 crew members were found affected. The vessel was hence isolated at anchor for 7 days, after which she was allowed to berth and proceed with the cargo ops.

The population on the whole island is creating havoc by blocking the roads and creating very long traffic jams. Travelling to and from the Port of Longoni is getting rather painful.

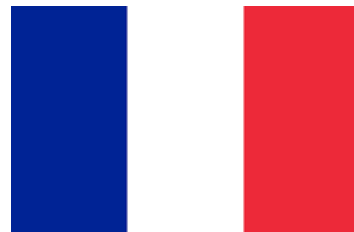

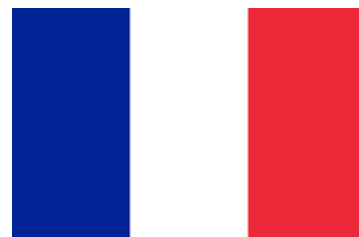

- CONFINEMENT** : The massive gathering of people (more than 50 persons) is prohibited. It is obligatory for all citizens in the Albanian territory to wear a mask in closed public spaces. The children younger than 11 years and other persons that cannot wear a mask on health reasons are excluded from this obligation. Currently there is a curfew during period 23 :00 – 06 :00.
- NON ESSENTIAL BUSINESS' CLOSURE** : Businesses are open, including bars and restaurants, which are required to respect safety protocols.
- BORDERS' CLOSURE** : Land borders of Albania with neighboring countries for the free movement of people are opened. Actually all nationalities are allowed to enter in Albania. Trucks and other cargo movement are allowed and continue normally. From 6th September all nationalities that enter in Albanian borders need to have 1) Vaccine Passport or 2) PCR Test (not later than 72hrs) or Rapid Antigen Test (not later than 48 hrs) or 3) Prove that they have passed COVID during the last 6 months.
- OTHERS** :

All seaports are open. There are no restrictions in handling of cargo vessels, ro-ro vessels, tankers and gas-carriers. Ferryboats vessels (including passengers) to/from Italian and Greek ports are allowed. Both shipping lines and passengers should respect the safety protocols. Actually all nationalities are allowed to enter in Albania (respecting the above mentioned restrictions). The yachts and other touristic boats are allowed in ports.

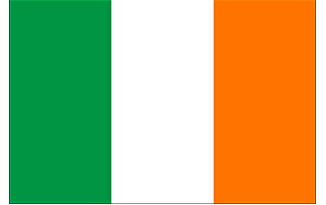

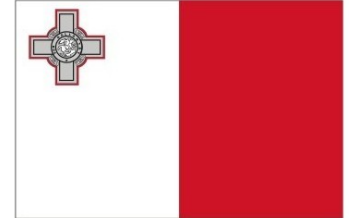

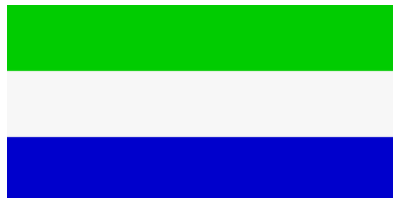

Bangladesh reported 172 fresh fatalities from Covid-19 and 7,248 new infections in the 24 hours to 8am on Wednesday. Of the 172 deceased – 94 men and 78 women.

Covid-19: Lambda variant found in Bangladesh: Bangladesh has identified the existence of the “Lambda” variant, a new Covid-19 strain which the World Health Organization has termed as “variant of interest,” first identified in Peru.

■ Bangladesh’s daily Covid deaths, new infections: on 17-08-21: The number of deaths of patients confirmed to have Covid-19 also rose for the second straight day with the health directorate reporting 198 deaths in the 24 hours until 8:00am on 17-08-21. Reported positivity rate was 19.18 percent, down from 21 percent reported the day before. Of those reported dead yesterday, 116 were male and 82 were female.

■ Covid-19: With the latest development, the total number of deaths reached 24,719, while the number of total infections rose to 1, 440,644 in the country.

■ The new record surpassed the previous high of 247 on Monday.

■ Mortality rate: So far, 16,243 men (65.71%) and 8,476 women (34.29%) have died from Covid-19 in Bangladesh. The mortality rate against the total number of cases detected so far stands at 1.72%.

■ Covid Infection: As many as 41,014 samples were tested across the country, with a positivity rate of 17.67%. To date, more than 8.52 million tests have been conducted around the country, leading to an overall test positivity rate of 16.91%.

■ At Districts: In the week until yesterday, 8,564 Covid-19 patients were detected in Dhaka, 2,636 in Chattogram, 1,137 in Sylhet, 994 in Cumilla and 987 in Gazipur districts.

■ Hospitals: ICU beds filling up:

In Covid-19 hospitals across the country yesterday, the general bed occupancy rate was 43 percent, ICU bed 74 percent, and HDU bed 70 percent.

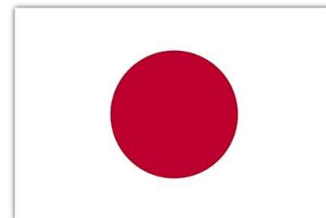

The status of visitors is assigned based on verification with information systems of Control Center covid-19 of the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Kazakhstan. "Red" status is assigned if a person has passed a PCR test for coronavirus and received a positive result. Holders of this status are ordered to observe a strict regime of home isolation or receive treatment in hospital. "Yellow" is assigned to contact persons. They are allowed to go out for groceries or to the pharmacy near the house, but are prohibited from visiting other public places. "Blue" will mean free movement everywhere, except in places where a PCR test is required (for example, at an airport). "Green" is a sign of complete freedom of movement for whom was tested negative or who has been vaccinated.
